7. Weave the improvement process systematically into day-to-day business activities as a routine "habit."

This is the big one. Substantive, sustainable continuous improvement requires clearly defined systematic processes rather than a one-off program. What's more, those systems must leverage the skills and knowledge of every employee to identify and implement improvements as part of their daily work.
